

John C. and Alex S. Snider Endowed Scholarship 2018 - 2019 Application



Colorado State University Online is pleased to announce that the John C. and Alex S. Snider Endowed Scholarship is available for the 2018-2019 academic year. Dr. John C. Snider was the Director of Continuing Education at Colorado State University from 1975 to 1986 and Vice Chancellor of the Colorado State University System (Fort Lewis College, the University of Southern Colorado, and Colorado State University) from 1986 to 1990. Upon leaving Colorado State, Dr. Snider established a fund for scholarships to be awarded to qualified nontraditional students who have the desire to “return to learning.” The first scholarship was awarded in November 1994.

To be **eligible** for the John C. and Alex S. Snider Endowed Scholarship Program, students must meet the following criteria:

- Be 25 years old or older at the time of application or have a nontraditional student life circumstance (single parent, etc.)
- Be enrolled in CSU Online for a minimum of three (3) academic credits (including distance education) during the 2018-2019 academic year
- Not admitted to the University for the 2018-2019 academic year
- Not yet obtained a bachelor’s degree

Applications will be given preference if postmarked by October 2, 2018. The recipient will be notified in writing. The award is to be used exclusively for CSU Online (Division of Continuing Education) credit courses. The scholarship in the amount of approximately \$800 or less will be awarded.
