- *For those who will be taking a course held on CSU's campus or have to park on campus, Monday through Friday, between 7am and 5pm, you will need a CSU guest parking permit. We will provide permits the day of the class or event. Be sure to follow all directions as to how to use/place the permit.*
- *In rare circumstances, a location may change or we may cancel a class due to weather. Should this occur, you will be contacted prior to the class session. This is **why we have asked for your e-mail address and your phone number. We hope you included that information as you register.***
- *For the first class session, we will have Osher signs at the building's main entrance, indicating the direction of the classroom.*

**Anthology Book Company**

422 E. 4th Street, Loveland, CO

From Fort Collins, drive SOUTH on College Ave/US-287 S/S College Avenue, continue onto N. Lincoln Avenue, turn LEFT at E 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Loveland. Anthology Book Company is on the RIGHT/SOUTH side of the street.

**Bonnell Building**

From Fort Collins follow US 287 into Loveland. Continue straight onto North Lincoln Ave. which turns into Cleveland Ave. Turn RIGHT onto E 4<sup>th</sup> Street. Bonnell Building will be on the right.

**College America**

From College Avenue and Harmony, go WEST on Harmony and turn LEFT/SOUTH at the next block onto Mason Street. Turn RIGHT/WEST into the first driveway. You will see College America in front of you at the NORTHWEST side of the parking lot.

**Colorado Welcome Center (Also Environmental Learning Center)**

3745 East Prospect Road, Fort Collins (A bit West of the I-25 Interchange)

Beginning at the intersection of College Avenue and Prospect - Go EAST on Prospect, through stop lights at Lemay, Timberline, and Summit View. You will pass a fair amount of open space on your RIGHT/SOUTH side. As you get close

to I-25, you will see two stop lights ahead (going up a hill). Before you reach either of those lights, you will see a brown sign on your RIGHT saying "Colorado Welcome Center." Turn into the drive just past that sign. As you curve along the road to the SOUTH, you will see a modern building on your RIGHT. Keep going and take the turn into the parking lot which is just to the SOUTH side of the building. You will see a green sign that says "Welcome to Fort Collins: Home of CSU." The classroom is at the far NORTH end of the building. **Note: The Welcome Center has asked us not to park in the row nearest to the building, they need to save that for Visitors. Thank you for helping us to abide by their request.**

## **Community Foundation of Northern Colorado**

**4745 Wheaton Drive, Suite 100, Fort Collins**

From Lemay and Harmony, GO EAST on Harmony for .2 miles until you get to Wheaton. TURN RIGHT/SOUTH at the first (right hand) turn lane you come to past Lemay – this turn takes you onto Wheaton). Go one block; go through stop sign, then turn RIGHT/WEST into first driveway you come to. You have just turned into a big parking lot used for a number of buildings. Once you enter parking lot, turn right as soon as you can; go a bit to the NORTH. You will see the Community Foundation Building on your RIGHT (it is first building you come to).

## **First Western Trust Bank**

**3003 E. Harmony Road, Suite 200, Fort Collins, CO**

First Western Trust Bank is in the New York Life building on east Harmony Road. Starting at Timberline, Go EAST on Harmony, continue driving EAST until you see Gifford Court (one block after the light at Corbett Drive and one block before Ziegler Road). Turn RIGHT/ (SOUTH onto Gifford Court, then turn LEFT to go into the parking lot. The front entrance and parking area are on the south side of the building.

## **Loveland Learning Center**

**NOTE:** There is not a number on the building, but the building has a large sign for University of Northern Colorado and Agrium Advanced Technology. Enter through the NORTHWEST entrance. (If you go through the east doors, the elevator is down the hall on the west side of the building.) Take the elevator to the second floor. CSU is in Suite 240. See choices of driving directions below.

**From Fort Collins:** If you are driving I-25 south from Fort Collins, take the Crossroads exit and go WEST to the first traffic circle, continue SOUTH through the second traffic circle. You will see brick buildings on your right (WEST). The second large building coming from this direction is the CSU Learning Center.

**Alternate route from Fort Collins:** Or another route from Fort Collins (staying off of I-25), from Harmony and Timberline, drive SOUTH on Timberline to CO 30 (EAST)(3.9 miles), turn LEFT onto CO 30 to first roundabout (1 mile). At the roundabout take first RIGHT onto Boyd Lake Road. On Boyd Lake Road to CO 24 E. (2.5 miles), there are a series of small sheds white buildings with green roofs at this turn. Drive CO 24 to Rocky Mountain Rd. (1 mile) and stay in lane for RIGHT turn. Turn RIGHT onto Rocky Mountain Rd. to second drive after the first roundabout. There two large buildings on your RIGHT. The door at the far right of the sign (UNC) is the door closest to the elevators that you will need to go to the CSU Learning Center.

**From Loveland:** If you are driving east on US-34, turn left (NORTH) at the first stop onto Rocky Mountain Avenue. Take Rocky Mountain Avenue north through four traffic circles. Stay on Rocky Mountain Avenue as you pass the Medical Center of the Rockies. Continue on Rocky Mountain Avenue to a complex of four large buildings on your left. The CSU Loveland Learning Center is in the third building away from you as you approach the complex.

### **MacKenzie Place**

Beginning at Harmony and Lemay - Go SOUTH on Lemay THROUGH the light at Harmony. Turn LEFT/EAST at the next stoplight which is Oakridge. Follow Oakridge to the East; go through the 4-way stop. Two hotels will be on your RIGHT (the Comfort Inn and also Homewood Suites). Just beyond Homewood Suites, you will come to Pleasant Oak Drive. Turn RIGHT/SOUTH. As you curve to the EAST on Pleasant Oak, you will see a very large building on your left.

From S. College Avenue/US-287 S. continue to follow US-287 S. Turn LEFT onto Carpenter Rd. Destination will be the right.

### **Reader's Cove Bookstore**

Go SOUTH on Lemay and go THROUGH the light at Harmony. Take the first RIGHT/WEST turn into a driveway. You will pass an island with a mailbox in it. At the end of the island, turn LEFT/SOUTH; then turn RIGHT/ WEST as soon as you can. (A big parking lot is now on your right side). The store is on the SOUTH side of that parking lot which is shared by Ace Hardware, Half Moon Bay Coffee Company, Fiona's Deli and more.

### **Rigden Farm Senior Living**

**2350 Limon Drive, Fort Collins, CO

Go EAST on Drake THROUGH the light at Timberline. Turn at the second RIGHT onto Iowa Drive. Take the first LEFT onto Limon Drive. You will see a 3-story, yellow building with a red roof on your left. This big building, 2350 Limon Street, is the location for the Osher Class. On street parking is available. Go into the glass doors (covered walkway, the main entrance to Rigden Farms) on the EAST side of the courtyard. Ask the receptionist for the Timberline Room.

## **Routt Hall**

**CSU Campus, Fort Collins, CO (southwest of College and Laurel)**

To Routt Hall parking lot: Starting at College and Laurel, go WEST on Laurel for one block. At Mason, turn LEFT/ SOUTH (street with the railroad tracks). Go 100 feet for so, the Routt Hall parking lot is to the LEFT/ EAST directly after you turn off Mason. We have made special arrangements for Osher class members to park in this lot for free after 3:30 p.m. on week days; a permit is not needed on Saturdays. As you walk from the parking lot to the EAST/toward College Avenue, you will see the back entrance (WEST side) of Routt Hall. If the door is locked when you arrive, use the doorbell to the right of the door handle. Routt Hall is a small historic red brick building with white wooden eaves.
