## Graduate Certificate (For Credit)



### Overview

Learn the principles of residential interiors and design in this three course series. Gain functional knowledge to evaluate:

- Residential design
- Floor plans
- Furniture arrangements
- Circulation patterns
- Use of color
- Lighting design
- Elements and principles of design as applied to interiors

#### Requirements

The Residential Interiors certificate requires successful completion of three courses (nine credits total). Admission to Colorado State University is not required to complete this certificate.

#### Required Courses (6 credits required)

- INTD 129 – Introduction to Interior Design (3 cr.)
- INTD 336 – Color (3 cr.)

#### Electives (select one course - 3 credits required)

- INTD 200 – Housing Values in America (3 cr.) (available on campus only)
- INTD 255 – Residential Interiors (3 cr.)

#### Time Frame

Completion of the certificate varies based on the amount of credits completed each semester.

#### Designed For

Students, family and consumer science instructors and teachers, real estate professionals, and others with a personal interest in interior design

#### What You Will Earn

Upon completion of this series of courses with passing grades, you earn a Certificate of Completion. Individual courses, but not the certificate, will appear on your official University transcript.
