Overview

This four-course certificate provides instruction and experience in current learning technology options that are used to enhance instruction in both the face-to-face classroom and at a distance. Completion of these courses will provide you with knowledge that will help you enhance the teaching and learning environment. You will learn to:

- Evaluate which technologies are appropriate for different learning experiences and environments
- Know the right questions to ask when identifying and investigating technology
- Apply technology to a learning experience
- Evaluate the impact of the technology on learning outcomes
- Develop basic web pages for use in instruction
- Enhance communication and interaction with distance learners
