


Posting a Kaltura Video in a Discussion


Class discussions can be augmented with the inclusion of Kaltura videos in student responses. Students will be able to choose a video or videos from their My Media or record videos and embed them directly in Canvas.

In the Discussion thread, click on the “Reply” icon.



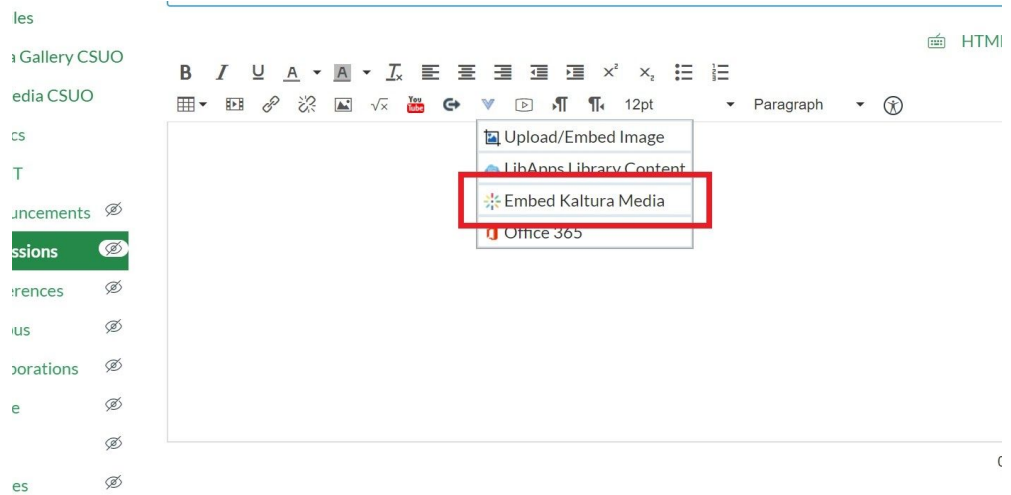

In the rich text editor, click on the “More External Tools” icon.

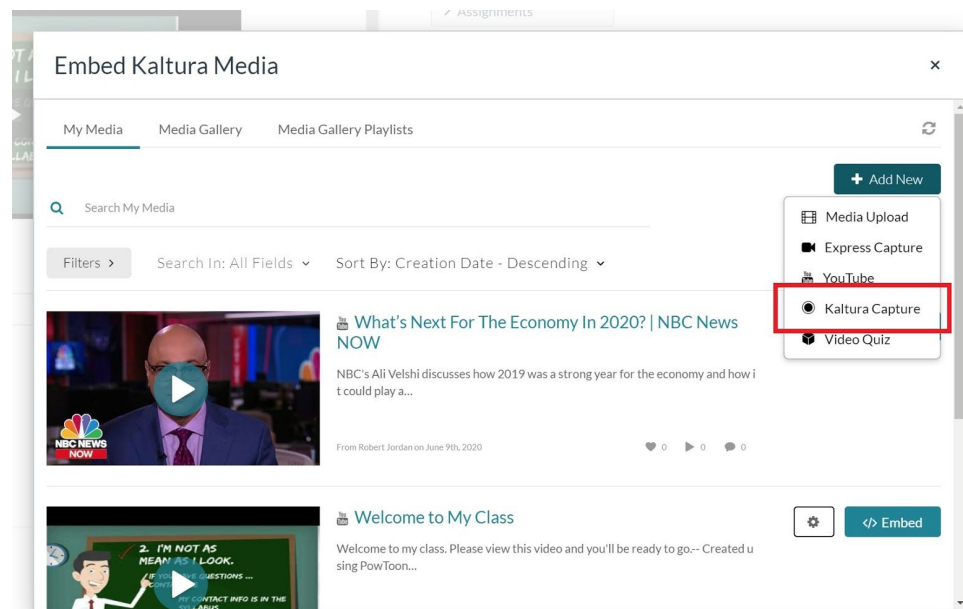

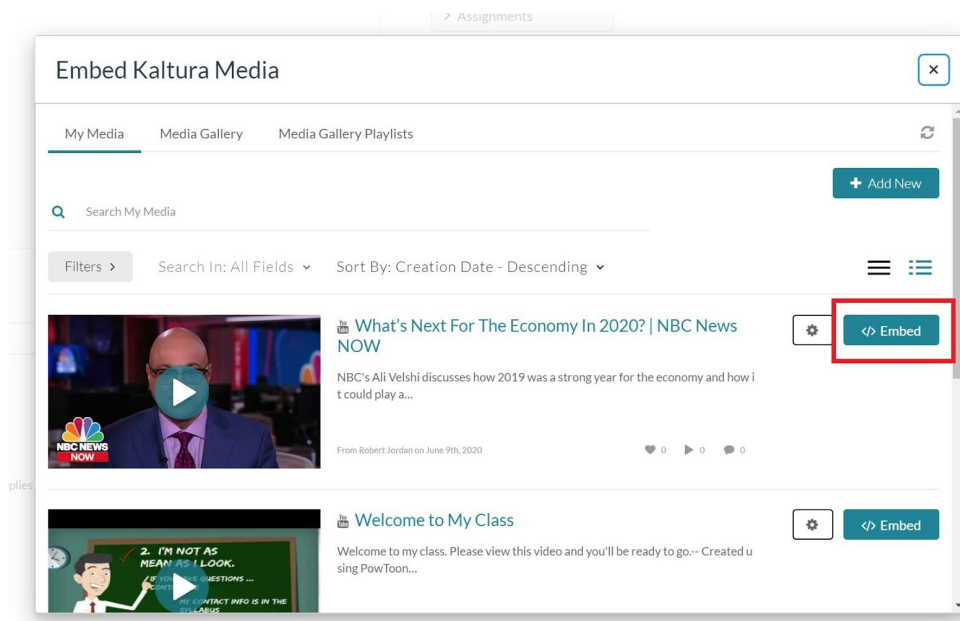
Select “Embed Kaltura Media” from the dropdown menu.



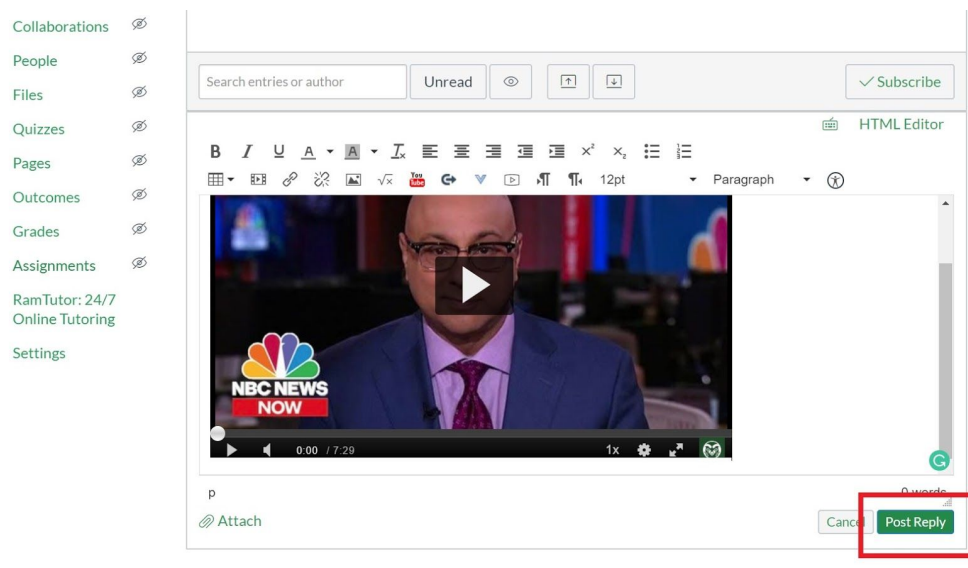
If you need to create a new video recording, click “Add New” then select the “Kaltura Capture” option from the dropdown menu. (See [“Recording your Video in Kaltura”](#).)



If you already have a video in your My Media folder, select the Kaltura video you want to use and click the “</> Embed” button.



Once the video embed appears in the text box, click the “Post Reply” button to post your video to the discussion thread.
