### Important Notes for 2024-2026 Schedule:

- “Online asynchronous” means that learning will be self-paced between the indicated dates, via an online platform.
- “Virtual” means classes will occur by attending a virtual class session, at the same time as your classmates (synchronous), as facilitated by the instructor.
- “In-person” means classes will occur at the Boulder Regional Training Center Facility.
- Class sessions are scheduled from approximately 9 am–5 pm except when half day is noted. Instructor and syllabus for each course will confirm exact times.
- 9 Elective credits (three 3-credit classes) are required to graduate. It is recommended to complete these as indicated on the above schedule.
- \* Varied credits for SOWK 688: students must complete a total of 15 credits (675 hours) for SOWK 688. 1 credit = 45 hours of agency-based learning. Placements may be completed in less than 4 semesters as long as 15 credits are completed over a minimum of two semesters.
- Credit totals each semester: students must be enrolled in 5 credits each semester to be eligible for financial aid.
- All dates above align with the University calendar to include finals week. The spring and fall semesters also include a week for spring and fall breaks.
