

## Overview

This online food safety training series ensures employees receive consistent and up-to-date information when they are trained. Courses within the program are updated regularly as policies change. Training topics include:

The program's courses are designed for food manufacturers to maintain Current Good Manufacturing Practices (cGMPs), which are the basic operational and environmental conditions required to produce safe foods. They ensure that ingredients, products, and packaging materials are handled safely and that food products are processed in a suitable environment. Course content caters to adult learners at all levels.
